General Manager's Remarks

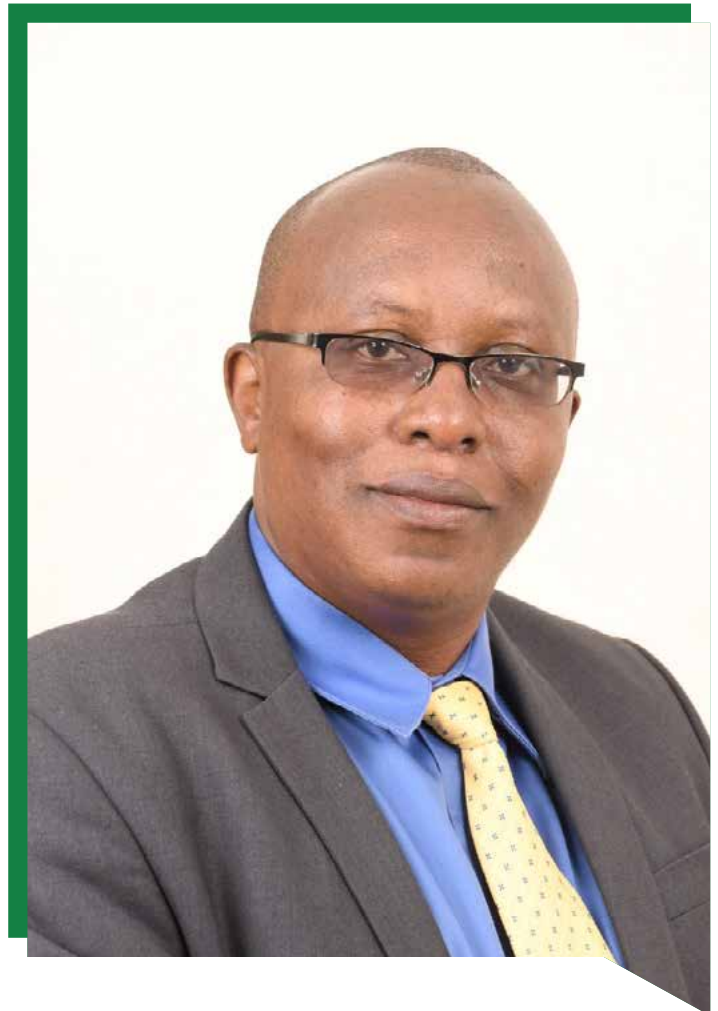
Honourable Members,

To carry out this mandate, I closely work with the Board of Directors, the Members, and the Staff Team to achieve the highest level of professionalism. I am greatly indebted to them for their efforts in ensuring that we move together to see the fulfilment of the Club mission; to provide a consistently superior country club experience for members, their families and guests with exceptional golfing, sporting, and dining facilities, in a friendly environment that fosters fun and comradeship.

Member centricity is our priority as we seek to enhance Member satisfaction through excellence in Service Delivery. We are keen to understand the needs and expectations of our members. We are currently implementing the feedback from the Membership survey that we conducted, which will go a long way to enabling us to be focused and intentional in enhancing the Member experience at the Club.

Our people are the most valuable resources to enable us to achieve our intended goals. We have embarked on the journey of improving on People and Performance for our staff. Several external Trainings in partnership with Utalii College have been rolled out for our staff. Internal training have also been undertaken. We wish to thank our members for volunteering to be facilitators for such trainings. Staff engagement sessions on an individual and corporate level as well as regular staff briefing sessions have been held with the sole purpose of improving our Customer Service, Communications and Product knowledge skills. From January this year we introduced the Balanced Score Card to the Management Staff and two evaluation sessions have been conducted in April and July respectively.



We have initiated several measures geared towards improving our internal Controls and processes to be Member friendly, while enabling us to be more operationally efficient. To this end a review of our Food and beverage controls, Prequalification of suppliers and Club internal controls in general is currently ongoing.

I encourage you to Patronize the Club and take advantage of the various activities that have been organized for your participation. Finally, I wish you a prosperous and fruitful second Half of the year 2024.

Chairman's Note

Welcome to the 2024 mid-year edition of the Country Vibes. As we come closer to end of year, I wish to reflect on key highlights relating to progress, we are making as a club.

As promised, my Board and Management will continue to lead guided by our Constitution and operate based on Limuru Country Club's Strategic pillars which are to:

1. Improve membership growth and satisfaction.
2. Promote and grow golf and gymkhana sports.
3. Improve existing and develop new club infrastructure.
4. Achieve club financial sustainability.
5. Enhance and develop the capacity of the organization.

During the year 2024, we have increased membership by over 200 members through the local residents, initiative. The increase in number of members is aimed at improving patronage at the club and improve subscriptions income, thus reducing current operational deficit. Our membership numbers are sub-optimal and the longer-term goal is to increase the number of active members to about 2,000 from the current figure about 1,100. A number of prospective local residents missed the last offer and discussions will be held at Board level to discuss the possibility of opening a short window that will allow those who missed, an opportunity to join.

As you may have noticed, patronage at the Club has increased substantially. Parking has been extended to accommodate the increasing demand. As we increase the parking spaces, we are also creating grounds for events, kids play area and other sports facilities like basketball and possibly paddle tennis. On the service side we are acquiring additional POS machines to reduce the billing bottleneck. We are also installing a kitchenette at the pool area to replace the current kitchenette that is well below standard.

Other low-cost projects aimed at creating space and enhancing operational efficiencies are progressing well. The main service road to the course is now graded and motoring well. The current garbage collection site will be moved closer to the gate for easier access. Caddies waiting area will move closer to their canteen, to allow



additional parking area. As we invest in machinery for the course, the yard for the machinery and equipment, will be redone to provide shelter and security for the machinery and equipment. Work on teeing off areas is progressing well having completed no.7 and 12 and work ongoing on no 13.

Our main club house re-furbishment and extension project is progressing well having received the architectural approvals and now awaiting the structural approvals from the County Government. Once received we will move on to the construction phase.

We have a busy calendar of events between September and November, in golf, gymkhana and social events. Kindly be on the lookout for the various updates on the Club's formal communication channels and participate fully in these activities.

On behalf of the Board of Directors, I would like to extend our sincere appreciation to you for the continued support provided to the Board and the various Board Committees. We wish you and your families, good health, prosperity, and happiness.

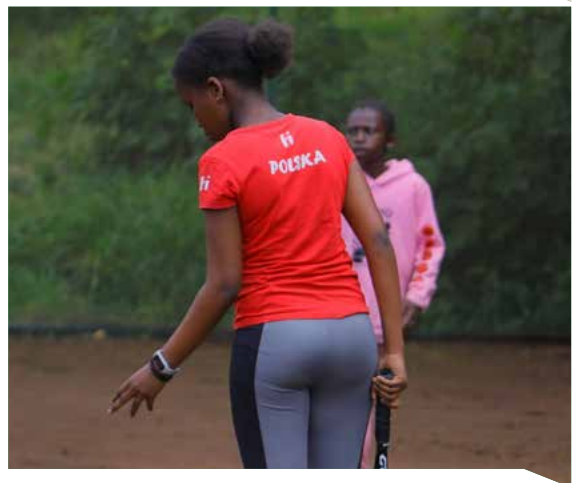


LCC Tennis 2024: A Year of Thriving Tournaments and Growing Tennis Enthusiasm

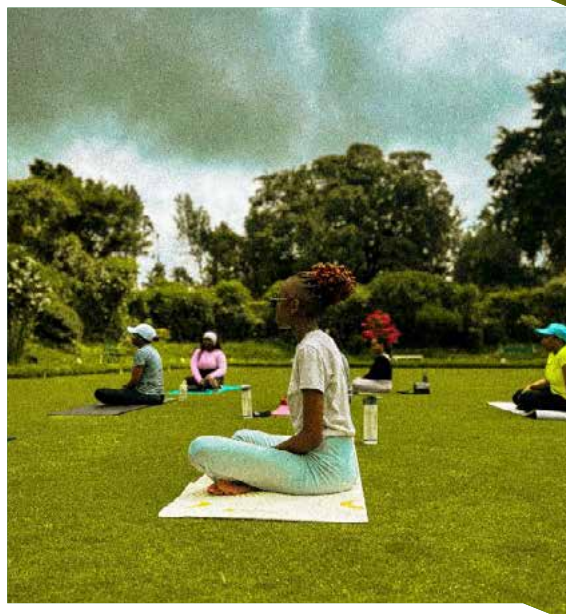
Discover Yoga at LCC: Embrace Wellness and Scenic Serenity

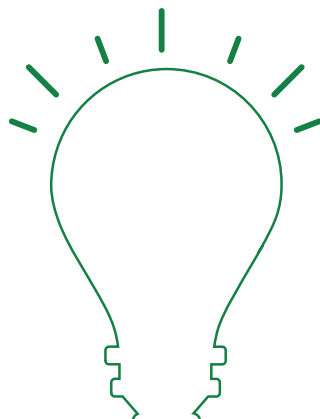
